The present outbuilding which seems at present to be used for storage and not used as another room or living quarters is small, unobtrusive and only has a very small window. The proposed building however is much larger and would have French doors/windows overlooking the rear of buildings in Agar Grove. This would mean loss of privacy for neighbouring properties at the back. As it is very noisy at the front of Agar Grove, it is a relief that the rear of the building is relatively normally quieter. This would be a disaster to develop the back of 158 with working and/or living areas which would very likely lead to much more noise. There has been a huge amount of building development visible from the back of Agar Grove recently and this proposal would take away further scarce open area and would deny future residents and wildlife including birds garden /yard space. The proposed style does not match in and is not suitable for this 19th century conservation area building.</p>
