Following our conversation last week
I am writing as you suggested.

The above applicant is my neighbour - the
Coach house in question's wall is also
my garden wall. I would object to
a window overlooking my property
but I understand the window will be
on the other side of the coach house.

More of a concern - a real concern
is my mature trees planted in the
bed against the wall. The roots
would surely be damaged as they
must grow underneath the coach house.

There is another large silver birch
tree which is a few feet away on
the south side. When I applied for
permission to create a space in
my garden to park a car - it was

turned down on account of possible
damage to the brick tree roots.

I do not want to make an undue fuss, but
the proposed work must make a big disruption
in the crescent, and do feel quite strongly
that these rather unique houses were
worth preserving in the way they were
designed.

Do you intend to inform residents
of the outcome of the application?
