Dear Mr Clark,

We realise that the formal consultation period for this applications finished at the beginning of this month but it has just come to my attention. I write below my objections to the above application, and hope these will be taken seriously. I write as a resident of Lindfield Gardens, which is just round the corner from the proposed development.

We totally oppose the loss of undeveloped green space in our local area as well as the impact that these additional dwellings will have on the water table movement in our neighbourhood. Please note - this site is double sloping and has underground aquifers passing through it and nearby. Loss of trees and green space will also have a detrimental impact on the area and the environment. In a conservation area, it is important to protect what limited undeveloped green spaces which are available.

Moreover, we understand the site has a dangerous and limited narrow access route and no provision for parking which would put a burden on the already limited street based parking in our neighbourhood.

Please regard this as formal objection to this application.
