Proposal: External alterations including the erection of 2 x Glass Reinforced Plastic (GRP) replica chimney stacks enclosing 6 x antennas and 4 x dish antennas at upper roof level and the installation of 7 x radio equipment cabinets at lower roof level.

Drawing Nos: CAM0124-101, CAM0124-103, CAM0124-104, CAM0124-105, Design & Access Statement and Covering Letter.

The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reasons:

Reasons for Refusal

The proposed replica chimney stacks, by reason of their size, design and prominent location, would be incongruous additions that would be detrimental to the appearance of the host building, the streetscene and the character and appearance of the Hampstead Conservation Area. The proposal is therefore contrary to policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies



DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
