During a whole year their builders consistently ignored Camden's Noise Restriction 4. For months they evaded purchasing whole day parking permits for their lorries and the 18 Parsifal Road began their building works in October 2014 and for over a year we as a constant barrage of digging, drilling, banging and all the infernal noises that go with the neighbours engage in major building works. We asked them repeated when was this sit end as it had seriously overrun from what we had originally been told. In the last months of 2015 the owners of 18 Parsifal Road, NW6 1UH, decided without applying for planning permission, to change the front of their house. Frenetic digging, began once again with mountains of rubble and dust. Camden repeatedly told them to so but they ignored this and continued until they finished the new construction knowing further an obligation to obtain planning permission first. They have now resorted to the well-known subterfuge of applying for retrospective plan permission hoping they can get away with it. 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					building noises did not stop on Saturdays after 13:00 hrs as stipulated in Camden's Noise Restriction Controls. They continued well into the afternoon and on several occasions even on Sundays in spite of us asking them to stop. Using their bins, 18 Parsifal Rd routinely cordoned off parking spaces in front of their house. Neighbours were unable to access residential bays they had paid for in a street where parking is extremely difficult at the best of times. Although everyone told them they could not do this, they carried on regardless for a year. In this way 18 Parsifal Road avoided spending vast sums of money purchasing day permits for their lorries and builders while at the same time depriving Camden Council of an important source of revenue.
