T1 Populus, Large, mature, pollarded tree. This tree has several cavities in both main stems. The stem to the North has a decaying cavity at the top. There is black staining approx. 1m below the cavity, this is water seeping down through the cavity. There are two more cavities at 2.2m above ground to the Northwest and at 2m above ground to the west. The decay is quite extensive behind the small openings and the two cavities are linked. There is a ridge forming near to these cavities which suggests reaction wood formation from the tree as it trys to strengthen this stem. The stem to the South has a large cavity at 3m above ground to the South. This cavity is from the removal of a sub-dominant stem some years ago. I was unable to ascertain the level of decay in this cavity. Given the trees size and proximity to properties, the suggested works are: Option 2: To re-pollard to the previous pollard points.
