I am the owner of number 43 Murray Mews, opposite the home where this planning application has been made. I have thought it important to forward to you feedback on these proposals.

I have been resident in the Mews for almost 12 years, during this time many properties have undergone changes. The Mews has quite a unique character of very diverse styles of dwellings, generally small to medium scale, and for the most part the variety creates a welcome richness. A quite distinct massing difference from Camden Mews.

Most of the newer construction projects have involved single story front extensions, and occasionally a top or roof conversion. The scale and location of these developments has invited a slightly unwelcome process of altering the building volumes, and consequently the character of simple yet quirky homes.

The design proposal for this application is imaginative and considered; however, the mass and scale is not appropriate to this Mews. Three stories immediately adjacent to the street is an over development and will impact the light levels that our house currently benefits from.
