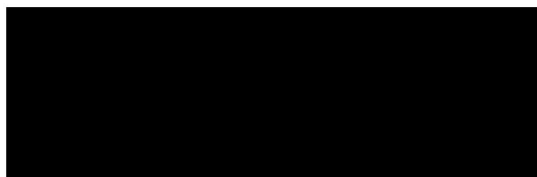
**PROPOSED WORKS TO TREES IN A CONSERVATION AREA**

I wish to carry out routine pruning in my garden with the intention of improving the overall appearance of the garden and curbing excessive or straggly growth. No tree will be removed. The aim is to maintain the garden, not to change it.

Following a telephone call to your office, I have completed the form which was e mailed to me and am returning it by post, as I found the process of submitting an application electronically too complicated to complete.

I have included a sketch showing the position of the specimens to be pruned and a description by tree surgeon, Mr Antony Wylam, of the proposed work. (Most of his information is also included on the form.) He has not included in his estimate my number 4 – the cutting back of an overhanging branch from an ironwood tree in the neighbouring garden – but has agreed to do this (and indeed recommended it).

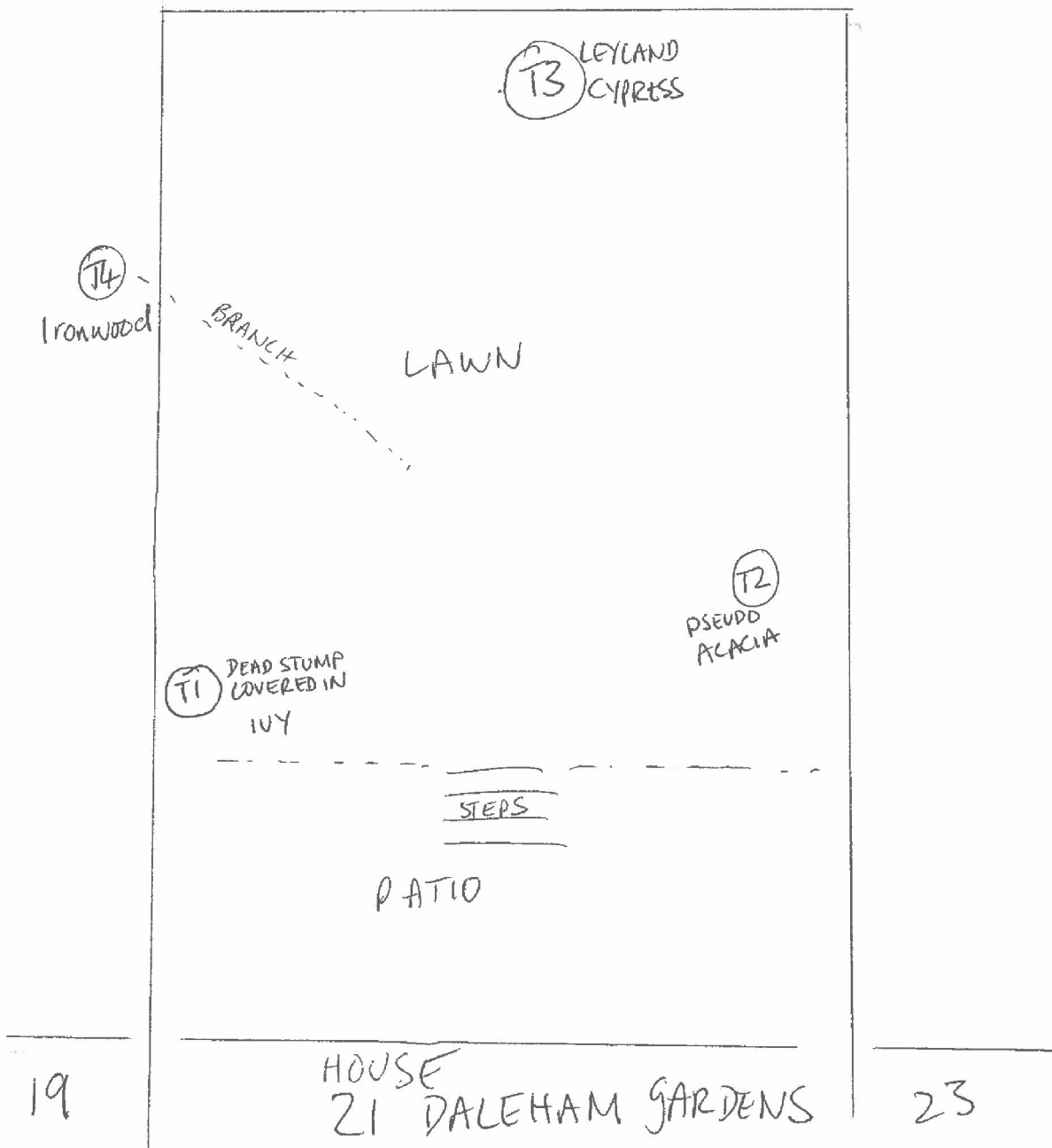

Further to our meeting yesterday I confirm  
my quotation for tree work discussed.

① Dead stump uproot it; Reduce height  
by 1 m including wig. Take wig out of thunder  
underneath to clear. Grab out small dead stump £25.00

② Pseudo Acacia; Clear trunk up to 18 ft  
to remove one broken branch, epicormic  
growth and 1 long Angely branch extending  
over lawn on its own. The tree will  
be a much better balanced specimen £250.00

③ Leiland Cypress a back border. Remove growth  
overhanging lawn. Reduce top new growth to  
previous trimming points. This would involve  
height lowering of about 3m, or 30% but the  
screen would be retained £200.00  
Council sanction should be investigated. Yours Sincerely
