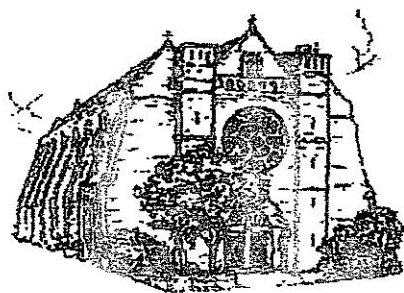

Last June I sent in a request regarding removal and pruning of overhanging trees and shrubs along Savernake Road. Some 10 years ago Camden Council installed wooden planters as requested by the local community. You requested additional information which I now include.

These trees and shrubs have now grown and are overhanging the pavement. We would particularly like to remove the large conifer and silver birch in Bay 1 obstructing our church notice board which is also rotting.

Bay 4 and 5 trees need pruning back so they do not obstruct pedestrians and the very tall ash tree in Bay 3 needs lopping to a manageable height (it is now about 20 feet tall).

I will attach photos to the email together with this letter and look forward to hearing from you.
