2015/6812/P	Christopher Oakley	27 Great James Street London WC1N 3ES	18/02/2016 17:39:31 WREP		The internal plans seem acceptable but I would object to the following: (a) the installation of the lift which is a "too modern" intrusion in a house of this period and does not even make the house wheelchair enabled; (b) the rear extension in which the lift will be housed destroys the uniformity of the appearance of the back of this terrace with its single small "closet" extension; and (c) the garden terrace and side trellises on top of the new kitchen is too big, too tall and is incompatible with the near empty character of the spaces to the rear of these properties and will greatly overshadow the gardens to either side (the one built at no.30 is an unacceptable intrusion into the back gardens of this fine terrace as it so overshadows the gardens to each side and obstructs their light and completely changes the view along the back of the terrace which hitherto had remained unchanged for nearly 300 years), another terrace over a kitchen in the garden at no 35 will make this worse.

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
