All Trees, selectively reduce by up to 4m, cutting back the overextended lateral limbs to form a more compact crown. There are several heavily overextended limbs over the colonnade building, that will need to be cut back to the approximate level of the guttering of the building. I.e. that will need to be cut back so they do not overhang the colonnade building at all.
