Chestnut - Approximately 21.00m. Reduce or remove one major limb to reduce potential hazard and risk of limb drop or tear out. Raise remaining crown by 3-3.50m to balance. Reduce back branches growing towards house by approximately 20% to give a minimum clearance of 1.50-2.00m. Remove dead wood. Thin crown density throughout by 20%. These actions will help reduce potential hazards, reduce weight burden and wind resistance.  
Reasons - The large limb to the rear of the tree has continued to deteriorate. The apparent longitudinal crack in the main stem close to the limb/stem union junction is now becoming a cause for some concern. It would certainly be prudent to greatly reduce the weight of this effected limb.
