Lime: Approximately 9.00m. This potentially large tree will certainly be over imposing upon the garden in the future. It would be prudent to consider removing the tree and planting a more suitable specimen. Fell to ground level and replace with more suitable specimen.

Willow: Approximately 7.00m. Overhanging from 19 Daleham Gardens. Reduce overhanging branches by 20-25% to abate nuisance and control encroachment. Front Garden:

Box: Approximately 7.00m. Overhanging from 19 Daleham Gardens. Reduce whole crown by approximately 20% to balance shape and tidy. Eucalyptus: Approximately 16.00m. Reduce crown approximately 30%, pull back from building and clear street light as general maintenance and to control encroachment.
