USE OF CRANES

- 23. The Licensee shall apply to the CEPC with a minimum of 10 working days' notice for permission to bring onto site any crane that will operate from the roadway.
- 24. A project plan setting out the dates and available details of all proposed access and lifting operations will be deposited with the CEPC on agreement of this Licence.

USE OF PETO PLACE SITE OPERATIVES

- 25. Site operatives and those visiting the site for any reason must not to be encouraged or permitted to access or exit the worksite from Peto Place or to stand, sit, smoke, eat, drink or loiter at any time in Peto Place or on the western pavement at the southern end of Albany Street.
- 26. Those managing the site will make every effort to minimise noise, dust, litter, excess light spill and any other nuisances as judged by the CEPC as arising from the site and that are likely to affect properties backing onto Peto Place.

MAINTAINING RESIDENT PARKING & ACCESS THROUGH PETO PLACE

- 27. Access for residents' vehicles to Peto Place using the entrances from Marylebone Road and Albany Street must be preserved at all times.
- 28. Vehicles waiting to load and unload in Peto Place must be marshalled to maintain good access and parking facilities for non-works traffic.
- 29. During working hours when deliveries and works vehicles are due on-site banksmen will be placed on-duty with the specific duty to manage and facilitate vehicle movements and access to Peto Place.
- 30. Banksmen will ensure that residents' vehicles are prioritised so that waiting times to gain access or to exit from Peto Place are kept to a minimum and are not longer than a 5 minute maximum.
- 31. Works traffic movements from Marylebone Road into Peto Place will be limited to a maximum number of [fifteen] movements each day.
- 32. The timing of vehicle movements shall be restricted so as to take place only during to the approved hours of work, as set out in this Licence.

PROTECTION AND REINSTATEMENT OF STREET FURNITURE TREES & PAVING

- 33. Prior to the start of the Works a condition survey and photographic record of footpath pavings, kerbs, street furniture, lamp posts, road surfaces and trees will be prepared by the Licensee and deposited with the CEPC.
- 34. By agreement with the CEPC the Licensee will arrange for the removal to the CEPC's works yard of specified lamp column(s), railings, bollards or other street furniture. These items are to be refurbished and replaced to the CEPC's satisfaction and specification at an agreed point towards the end of the Works Period.
- 35. The CEPC grants permission for the temporary removal of the four ornamental trees planted adjacent to the car park ramp in Peto Place but subject to the Licensee having provided to the CEPC prior proof of having received all appropriate local authority or other relevant permissions.
- 36. The reinstatement of these four trees will be of a type, size, to a specification and at a time to be agreed by the CEPC.
