Details of drainage required by condition 11 of planning permission 2014/4381/P dated 04/07/2014 (for the demolition of existing warehouse building (Class B8) and redevelopment for a mixed use building ranging from 8-12 storeys comprising 1,620sqm employment floorspace (Class B1), 154 residential flats, the provision of a public ramp access to the Regents Canal towpath, and associated landscaping and other works relating to the public realm).

1 Reasons for granting permission:

The details submitted demonstrate that the sustainable urban drainage system would see a reduction in outflows of 15% in accordance with the requirements of condition 11 and consistent with the Sustainability Statement submitted as part of the original application.

The details submitted have been assessed by the Council and Thames Water in relation to the approved scheme, the site and its surroundings. They are considered sufficient to satisfy the requirements of Condition 11 and the details are in general accordance with policies CS13 and CS16 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and policies DP22, DP23 and DP32 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

2 You are advised that conditions 3, 4, 6, 9, 10, 12, 14, 15 and 17 require the submission of further details which remain outstanding and must be approved before the relevant stage of the development.
