Fraxinus excelsior - This tree has been heavily reduced in the past and has a lot of reaction growth, resulting in a dense over crowded canopy. A 30% thin and crown clean will open the crown up to form a more natural looking canopy, also allowing more light to enter the garden whilst reducing the 'wind sail effect' helping to maintain a solid structure. Rubbing and crossing branches will be removed as will any deadwood.

Betula sp X 3 - Remove via sectional felling, finishing cut flush with ground level.

Ligustrum lucidum X 1 - Remove via sectional felling, finishing cut flush with ground level.

The purpose of the removal of these smaller trees is due to a rather over crowded garden and thus to give better chances of further development to the surrounding trees that are to remain. Please see illustration.
