Prune away x1 15cm diameter stem growing into party wall. Crown lift over footpath to above statutory height. Lombardy Poplar (Poplus nigra 'Italica') TPO – T7 Rear right boundaryReduce back to previous points of reduction to maintain cyclical pruning schedule. Remove all ivy form tree and stem. Remove x1 dead stem
