The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 13 January 2015 and decided to **OBJECT** for the following reasons:

Reasons for objection:

- 1 The evidence which has been submitted with the application to remove the tree is insufficient to demonstrate that this is the case;  
No evidence from crack and level monitoring demonstrating seasonal movement has been submitted. Root identification failed to identify this species of tree. No BRE damage classification has been submitted with the report. No costs or details of repair or alternative methods of damage mitigation have been made available.  
The loss of berries from trees is part of the natural cycle and while it may be a nuisance, the problem is not considered a sufficient reason to remove a tree.  
the application has been refused to protect the visual amenity the tree provides and to preserve the character of the area.



**A Tree Preservation Order has been served on the tree/s and no work should be carried out without the prior consent of the Council.**
