The centre is ready for Mr Bakall to visit and verify the work that has been done.

About the air conditioning, because of the limited period of time that centre was permitted to use as a place of worship as well as a community centre, it will be difficult to justify the cost and the work involved. As you may know that the air conditioning needs a planning permission and landlords agreement.
