Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Bay - Reduce height by two thirds  
1 x Pyrocanthus - Prune back from lawn by 1m  
1 x Fig - Prune back from lawn by 1m and reduce crown by 25%  
1 x Walnut - Prune back branches low in canopy by 1-2m

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 22 January 2015 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by the Council.



- 3 Please note that any approval given by the Council does not give an exemption from the requirements to comply with the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 (as amended), or any other Acts offering protection to wildlife. Of particular note is the protection offered to bats, birds and their nests from construction works.
