Details of protective fencing pursuant to condition no. 8 of planning permission granted on appeal on 18th July 2013 [planning ref. 2012/2720/P] for the erection of 3 storey building with double basement for use as a single-family dwellinghouse (Class C3) (following demolition of existing dwellinghouse).

Informative(s):

1 Reasons for approving details:

The submitted details are considered sufficient to demonstrate that the trees on site and on neighbouring sites will be adequately protected during development. Details include methods of fencing, subterranean tree defences, scaffolding poles



and associated site photographs. The tree protection measures are in line with BS5837:2012 - Trees in relation to design, demolition and construction.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the trees.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies CS15 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy.

You are advised that all conditions relating to appeal decision APP/X5210/A/13/2190084 allowed on 18 July 2013 which need details to be submitted, have been approved.
