A Grade II Listed Property situated in The Hampstead Heath Conservation Area and The Hampstead Heath Metropolitan Open Land. My rear garden directly adjoins the property noted in the planning application. I am writing in order to object to these plans. Soon after we took possession on No.1 in 2006 we were promised by Albany Limited that no future development would take place on this piece of land (part of the garden) that the Company annexed from the curtilage of The Old Court House Estate, and would not become an additional part of The Jack Straws Castle property. After Studying these plans I have come to the conclusion that this huge garden shed is unsightly taking into account the height, scale and bulk which are overbearing and will result in an adverse and unacceptable impact on and to the amenity of my and my neighbours properties. The visible high wall directly facing our three homes will be the highest and most unsightly one. All three homes of The Old Court House currently enjoy the benefit of looking out onto green open space, which will be materially and detrimentally affected by the position and scale of the proposed Development. I am also extremely concerned and worried that if planning is given the go ahead, then Albany Limited would press to continue and further develop the site particularly as they have already verbally given notice that they intend to demolish the Old Wall that separates the curtilage of The Old Court House and Jack Straws Castle.
