The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** planning permission for the following reasons:

Reason for Refusal

1 The proposed dormer window, by virtue of its siting, design and appearance, represents an inappropriate form of development, that would be detrimental to the character and appearance of the host building and would fail to preserve and enhance the character and appearance of the Fitzjohns Netherhall Conservation Area, contrary to Policy CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy and Policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving



Camden's heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
