					We are also concerned about a potential loss of privacy. We are unclear from the planning description as to whether this will mean that we will be overlooked. If so, that again will have a significant and deleterious impact on us.
					Finally, the test works carried on the basement of No.32 in December 2015 made it intolerable to have any kind of conversation amongst ourselves. The noise was quite extraordinary. The proposed extension and basement evacuation will cause a lot of nuisance and disturbance to our operational day for several months and have severe consequences to running our business efficiently. Most of our business is creative and there is a great deal of work by phone. It will be almost impossible to work here with drilling and other noise going on in the background.
