Work to group of three mature Robinia at southern end of New Square following prudent recommendations within report as outlined:

(Tree identifiers refer to tree safety survey plan)

Arb Consultant Comments "The current physiological and structural condition of T55 appears superior to its neighbours; however the presence of the cabling system to them may have affected the distribution of its root system (assuming the supports have been in place for some years).

If T55 is retained in the absence of the other two trees, light crown reduction may be prudent to improve its structural stability (by approx. two metres of current height and maximum spread). Much of the visual appeal of the group has already been lost and, although none of the trees in the group represents a risk of failure (due to the presence of the cabling) I suggest the removal of all three trees should be considered. This would facilitate replanting with a new group of trees to provide future amenity in this part of the grounds".

Works Schedule

Tree removal work (T54 & T56)

- Remove all existing wire cable bracing from all trees (the eye bolts will be left in retained tree - T55)
- Using rope lowering and rigging techniques, dismantle poor quality trees T54 and T56 to flat stumps at near ground level in readiness for grinding
- Grind out both stumps to approx. 200-300mm below ground level to allow re-instatement of grass area
- Guards will be used to control the spread of flying debris during grinding

T55 crown reduction work (to alleviate weight loading and create smaller canopy dimensions)

- Carry out crown reduction work on retained tree T55 by a maximum of 2m from height and lateral spread with an emphasis on longer protruding sections back into the profile of the forming internal crown
- All cuts to be made to secondary growth points maintaining shape and form at all times
