The application does not submit any new reports on the effect that the increased width and height would cause to neighbours, notably 17 Elliott Square, the property most affected by this proposal to amend the permission. The line of sight will suffer vertically and to the side, and the shadow cast to the garden of 17 Elliott Square will be adversely affected as well. I do not object to the changes to the front elevation of the entrance to the car park, but I respectfully submit that no variation should be granted which will increase the detriment suffered by neighbours generally and 17 Elliott Square in particular. The developers must not be allowed to come back and achieve piecemeal what they felt that they could not get in the original application. This is no more than an attempt to increase the value of the house in question at the expense of the living environment of neighbours and 17 Elliott Square in particular. Accordingly, the application should be rejected. Ends.
