Proposed Work:

REAR GARDEN: 1 x Leylandii - Remove growth that overhangs lawn, reduce top new growth to previous trimming points (lowering by approx 3m or 30%);
1 x Acacia - clean trunk up to approx 6m, remove dead or broken branches;
1 x Ironwood (adjacent property at no. 19) - cut back one branch which extends over lawn
1 x Dead stump - reduce height by 1m (including ivy), take ivy out of shrubs underneath, grub out small dead shrub.

The Council has considered your notification of intended works to trees dated 11 February 2016 and does not wish to object.

- 1 This notice is valid for 2 years from the date of this letter or until the work is completed, whichever is the sooner.
- 2 You are advised that the appropriate standards for tree work are set out in BS 3998: 2010. Failure to ensure that the proposed works are carried out to these standards may result in damage to the tree(s) and may result in legal action by




the Council.
