YOUR COMMENTS ON THE CASE

I was very disappointed and alarmed (as a local resident) to hear of a planning application for another betting shop on this stretch of Kilburn High Road. I walk past the area relating to the application

regularly. There are at least three bookmakers within a very small radius of this one proposed. It is very depressing to think there could soon be another. Kilburn High Road is a diverse road with a good mixture of independent and chain retailers and services and sadly it is in danger of becoming largely populated by bookmakers and loan shops. I can think of no local residents whom this application would benefit, as anyone wishing to use a bookmakers is already very well served. Planning applications for local services should have some consideration for residents, not just business owners. For the high road to thrive and be a desirable place to visit long term applications like this one need to be strongly resisted.
