We live in 40D Caversham Road, second-floor flat with large side window that faces the site of the proposed development.

As an immediate neighbour, we are of the view that the proposed development will have a serious impact on our standard of living. Our specific objections are as follows:

Over-development

• The proposed development, due to its size and siting, represents an un-neighbourly form of development that would have an adverse impact on 40 Caversham Road by reason of an overbearing effect. Building 18 units over 6 floors on such a small site is clear example of over-development.

Loss of privacy and overlooking

- There are windows in the proposed development which would face our side window and would
 result in us being overlooked and causing a loss of privacy because of the close proximity and height
 of the proposed development
- The proposed development would overlook our garden which would lead to a loss of privacy

Overshadowing/loss of light

- The proposed development would lead to a significant and unacceptable loss of sunlight and daylight and will be in breach of our legal right of light
- The proposed development would result in reduced sunlight and daylight entering our garden, preventing enjoyment of our garden

Public services

- The proposed development will generate a significant increase in the amount of local traffic
- The proposed development will reduce the amount of car parking available to an unacceptable level
- The proposed development includes insufficient landscaping
- Any excavation work could have a serious adverse impact upon the stability of the existing structures

Further notes:

- The drawings of 40 Caversham Road submitted in the planning application are extremely misleading because none of them show our side window
- Same applies to the "Exterior Street Views" document which (cleverly for applicants and worryingly for us) hides our side window as if it doesn't exist

 Same applies to the "Daylight, Sunlight & Overshadowing Report" which only mentions 40A and makes no mention of 40D
