



- Notes:
1. Piling shall be installed in accordance with the Specification and with the 'Specifications for Piling' as included in the contract documents.
  2. The Piling Contractor is to design the piles using the experience in piling in similar soils to those encountered on site.
  3. The maximum diameter of any pile shall not exceed 400mm.
  4. The maximum length of any pile shall not exceed 20m.
  5. The maximum depth of any pile shall not exceed 15m.
  6. The Piling Contractor shall refer to the following notes:
  7. The Piling Contractor shall be advised that the Engineer and Subject to Local Authority approval prior to the commencement of the works.
  8. Concrete used in the piles is to be minimum strength grade 35 'N/mm<sup>2</sup>' with a minimum cement content of 340 kg/m<sup>3</sup>, and a maximum water content rate of 175, all in accordance with BS EN 12620 (AC 10).
  9. The piles are to be cast in a minimum of 100mm above cut off level, and balance removed back down to the precast cut off level.
  10. The type of the piles are to be left in sound condition, with the replacement cap left protruding to the ground level cap, to allow for future use.
  11. The replacement to be left in sound condition, with the replacement cap left protruding to the ground level cap, to allow for future use.
