Whilst the CGCA generally supports urban greening proposals, the excessive nature of these proposals result in visual clutter that is inappropriate in a conservation area. Further, the CGCA objects to the inappropriate lighting, which mars the façade and where there are insufficient details to understand the effect of the proposed lighting on the facades. The examples provided by the applicant are not directly comparable, as they are not located in a central, high-density conservation area. A proper lighting visualisation is needed to assess this application.
