I write as a homeowner and potential neighbour of the proposed new house in Kemplay Road (2015/4373/P). I object the revised planning application because I am concerned by a number of issues - the proposed architectural design itself which does not enhance or add to the historic looks and feel of the conservation area, a basement, the introduction of a light well within two metres of the payment, which is contrary to Camden's own guidance, and the subsequent loss of a front garden.
