1 The proposal includes an extensive green wall which contains suitable planning for the site. The irrigation and maintenance plan are sufficient to demonstrate that the green wall will be sustainable in the long term future. The green roof provides a broad range of species and plant types and is considered to enhance the biodiversity of the site. The submitted details satisfactorily demonstrate that the green roof and green wall are suitably designed and secures measures for ongoing maintenance.

As such, the proposed development is in general accordance with policies CS13, CS14, CS15 and CS16 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP22, DP23 and DP24 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies. The proposed development also accords with policies 5.1, 5.10, 5.11, 7.4 and 7.6 of the London Plan March 2015.
