1 Reason for approving the details:

The submitted details of cycle storage are acceptable with the details being in accordance with the Council's standards. Two parking spaces have been provided as per the wording of the condition. The spaces would be secure and located at ground floor level for ease of access. In addition, they would be located behind the entrance lobby to remove them from view within the public realm.



The site's planning history has been taken into account when coming to this decision.
