No permission has been sought from West Hill Court to fell that tree, nor is it likely to be forthcoming if such permission was sought.</p> <p>The proposed wall along the pond facing perimeter of our garden is unnecessarily high and close to some of the flats. Not only will it result in the current view being obstructed but it may also affect the value of the property.</p> <p>All the above (and more) had been dealt with in communications between West Hill Court management committee and CoL and constructive proposals were put forward for consideration. However these seem to have been ignored without good reason being provided for doing so.</p>
