Background and context

The Sainsbury's store is located on a busy shopping high street along Kilburn High Road. The store occupies the ground floor of a mixed use four strorey building. The site is designated as within the Kilburn High Road Town Centre, according to the Carnden Planning Policy Map.

Sainsbury's has been located at the site for many years, having originally occupied a smaller store at the site before its extension in 1999. Planning permission PW9902027R1, for the "Installation of a new shopfront, as shown on drawing numbers; PL01, 2, 3, 4 and 5A", was approved on 17 March 1999 and allowed for the extension of the store.

A further extension of the store (LPA ref: 2007/5652/P) was approved on 16 January 2008, allowing for the "Installation of a new shopfront to retail unit (an extension to adjacent Sainsburys unit)." This application permitted the creation of the shopfront and floorspace that Sainsbury's continues to occupy today.

Permission has also been granted for the installation of various adverts on site in the past, under LPA reference 2007/5646/A and 2008/1384/A.

Proposed ATM

The ATM is proposed to be installed in a highly visible area to allow for natural surveillance, thereby allowing for safe use. It is located on the front elevation of the building, along Kilburn High Road.

The ATM will be made from a mixture of steel, glass, fibreglass and plastic, with a digitally printed vinyl surround. The ATM if of a high quality design and would help improve the appearance of the existing shopfront, therefore complying with Policy DP30 of the Camden Core Strategy (2010). Additionally, the ATM is in proportion with the existing shopfront and increases visual interest at street level, in accordance with Policy DP24 of the Camden Core Strategy (2010).

The inclusion of an ATM at the store is typical of Sainsbury's stores. This external ATM will provide customers and passers-by with an additional service within the town centre without causing harm to the amenity of the local area.
