Reason: Dangerous (Decaying pocket at height of 2m)

Reduce and shape crown(s) by approximately 40%, removing lateral growth by approximately 4-5m, cutting back to nearest suitable growing point, to leave a flowing branch line without stumps and the main canopy framework to B.S.3998:13.4.1.

(Please note: The % relates just to the tree canopy and not the entire tree height).

Remove all major dead and diseased wood and generally clean up canopy. Rake up all timber and arisings resulting directly from the above works and transport from site.

Leave all working and access areas in a clean and tidy condition and hand over to client.

2. Species: 1 x Populus (Poplar) - T2 on plan

Reason: Dangerous

Reduce and shape crown(s) by approximately 40%, removing lateral growth by approximately 4m, cutting back to nearest suitable growing point, to leave a flowing branch line without stumps and the main canopy framework to B.S.3998:13.4.1.

(Please note: The % relates just to the tree canopy and not the entire tree height).

Remove all major dead and diseased wood and generally clean up canopy. Rake up all timber and arisings resulting directly from the above works and transport from site.

Leave all working and access areas in a clean and tidy condition and hand over to client.

3. Species: 1 x Populus (Poplar) T3 on plan

Reason: Dangerous

Reduce and shape crown(s) by approximately 40%, removing lateral growth by approximately 3m, cutting back to nearest suitable growing point, to leave a flowing branch line without stumps and the main canopy framework to B.S.3998:13.4.1.

(Please note: The % relates just to the tree canopy and not the entire tree height).

Remove all major dead and diseased wood and generally clean up canopy. Rake up all timber and arisings resulting directly from the above works and transport from site.

Leave all working and access areas in a clean and tidy condition and hand over to client.

Northbridge House Senior School - ROSSLYN HILL

1. Species: 1 x Prunus (Cherry) - T19

Remove all major dead wood, snags, pegs and broken branches exceeding 10 mm in diameter or 100mm in length and leave canopy clean and tidy. Rake up all timber and arisings resulting directly from the above works and transport from site.

Leave all working and access areas in a clean and tidy condition and hand over to client.

2. Species: 1 x Prunus (Cherry) - T18

Reason: leaning

Reduce and shape crown(s) by approximately 30-35%, removing lateral growth by approximately 3-4m, cutting back to nearest suitable growing point, to leave a flowing branch line without stumps and the main canopy framework

(Please note: The % relates just to the tree canopy and not the entire tree height).

Remove all major dead and diseased wood and generally clean up canopy. Rake up all timber and arisings resulting directly from the above works and transport from site.

Leave all working and access areas in a clean and tidy condition and hand over to client.

3. Species: 1 x Platanus (Plane) - T3

Reason: Overgrown, Shade nuisance, health and safety.

Reduce and shape crown(s) by approximately 30-35%, removing lateral growth by approximately 3-4m, cutting back to nearest suitable growing point, to leave a flowing branch line without stumps and the main canopy framework

(Please note: The % relates just to the tree canopy and not the entire tree height).

Remove all major dead and diseased wood and generally clean up canopy. Rake up all timber and arisings resulting directly from the above works and transport from site.

Leave all working and access areas in a clean and tidy condition and hand over to client.

5. Species: 1 x Acer Pseudoplatanus (Sycamore) - T23

Remove all major dead wood, snags, pegs and broken branches exceeding 10 mm in diameter or 100mm in length and leave canopy clean and tidy. Rake up all timber and arisings resulting directly from the above works and transport from site.

Leave all working and access areas in a clean and tidy condition and hand over to client.

6. Species: 1 x Prunus (Cherry)

Reduce and shape crown(s) by approximately 30-35%, removing lateral growth by approximately 3-4m, cutting back to nearest suitable growing point, to leave a flowing branch line without stumps and the main canopy framework

Reduce and shape crown(s) by approximately 30-35%, removing lateral growth by approximately 3-4m, cutting back to nearest suitable growing point, to leave a flowing branch line without stumps and the main canopy framework

Remove all major dead and diseased wood and generally clean up canopy. Rake up all timber and arisings resulting directly from the above works and transport from site.
