The Council has considered your application and decided to refuse planning permission for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

1 The proposed antennas and associated equipment cabinet, by reason of their siting, scale and massing at high level in a prominent location, are incongruous additions that would add visual clutter and be significantly detrimental to the character and appearance of the host building, the street scene and the Hampstead Conservation Area. The proposal is therefore contrary to policies CS5 (Managing the impact of



growth and development) and CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's Heritage) of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies and policies 7.4 (Local Character) and 7.8 (Heritage assets and archaeology) of the London Plan and paragraphs 56-68 and 126-141 of the National Planning Policy Framework.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
