The Council has considered your application and decided to **refuse** advertisement consent for the following reason(s):

Reason(s) for Refusal

The display of the banner, by reason of its size and visually prominent location would result in an overly dominant addition which would be harmful to the visual amenity of the streetscene, the character and appearance of the conservation area and the setting of the surrounding listed buildings, contrary to Camden's Local



Development Framework Core Strategy policies CS5 (Managing the impact of growth) and CS14 (Promoting high quality places and conserving our heritage), and Camden's Local Development Framework Development Plan policies DP24 (Securing high quality design) and DP25 (Conserving Camden's Heritage).

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
