Change of use from studio offices (Class B1a) to residential use (Class C3) at ground and part mezzanine floor levels in connection with the existing residential use on the upper floors to form a single dwelling house (Class C3).

Reason for refusal:

The ground and mezzanine floor levels are already in Class C3 residential use and therefore the development is considered to have begun prior to the determination of criteria a-d as set out in sub-paragraph O.2. As such, the proposal does not accord with Condition O.2 of Class O of Part 3 of The Town and Country Planning (General Permitted Development) (England) (Amendment) Order 2016.
