This Committee acts on behalf of the Council for British Archaeology in respect of Listed buildings and Applications within the Greater London area. The Committee discussed the above case at its meeting on Tuesday, 29 March 2016 and made the following observations:

Grade II listed. Whilst the Committee welcomed the appropriate change of use and retention of original features throughout the building major concerns were expressed as under:

- § The insertion of dormers throughout the building across the roof slopes would harm the building's significance;
- § The lift shaft was also thought to be an inappropriate addition;
- § Externally the Committee held that the proposed east and west extensions would significantly alter the appearance of a listed building.

Overall the Committee endorsed the Twentieth Century Society/Historic England's views on the proposed development and suggested that the LPA reconsider the matter.
