					If it is decided to agree to the principle of a roof terrace, then the following revisions should be made to reduce its impact.
					• the railings should be reduced in height to the minimum of 1.100m required by the Building Regulations
					• it might be necessary to include a 1.700m high privacy screen on the side of the terrace facing the houses in Prince Albert Road. There is no need to include a privacy screen on the other three sides, and here the railings should be left open to reduce their impact
					• it is not clear how the access to the terrace is to be achieved, it should be kept as discreet as possible
					• the thickness of the floor finish should be reduced from 250mm to a minimum to lessen the overall height
					• there is no need to add 290mm to the height of the external walls
					• the front railings should be behind the sightline of the existing front parapet when viewed from the opposite side of Albert Terrace Mews
					• any lighting on the terrace and its access would pollute the surroundings and should not be allowed
					• faux hedges would be completely inappropriate, any planting should be natural in pots and planters and positioned inside the railings.
