I am writing to strongly oppose the plans of converting the Police Station into a 420 student Belsize Park school in Hampstead.

There is absolutely no need for yet another school in Hampstead as we already have 55 local school for children that live in the immediate area.

1:How could a school that is not even close by be allow to transfer into this area?

2:The amount of noise, pollution is already twice the limit for UK or EU- that will only increase with the amount of cars coming twice a day to drop-off and pick-up the kids. And you are not even taking into consideration the construction of HS2 and the Cycle Superhighway. The whole area will just come to a complete standstill...as it already does each day at 3pm...

3: TRAFFIC- another, potentially, 800-850 people every day in already congested area will be absolutely unmanageable.
