On behalf of the Somers Town Neighbourhood Forum, I have been instructed to submit the following as an addendum to the objections submitted by the Forum to the above mentioned Planning Application , on April 4th 2016. :-

Draft Policy C5 in submission draft Camden Local Plan refers to development being vulnerable to terrorism and if ever a building was vulnerable to terrorism it is the Crick - even more than the British Library or St Pancras - prIncipally because of the material that could be released into the environment. The 25 storey tower block, proposed on Plot 7, is almost an invitation to terrorists .... ie it is a potential security risk. Para 4.94 of the draft Local Plan requires the design of such buildings to "include appropriate and proportionate security and community safety measures and follow design principles contained within Government publication 'Protecting Crowded Places: Design and Technical issues' (2012) .

The Forum would submit therefore that Planning Application 2015/2074/P should be refused planning permission on the grounds that:-

• The proposed 25 storey tower block on Plot 7 is a potential security risk. No evidence has been submitted that it has been designed to meet 'Protecting Crowded Places: Design and Technical issues' 2012. As such it represents a massive potential threat to national security and the safety and well being of the immediately adjoining community in Somers Town / King's Cross - St Pancras.
