We are residents in Plimsoll Building located on 2 Wollstonecraft Street and Handyside Street, Kings Cross, NIC 4BT.

We have a 19 month old baby and we wish to state our objection to the submitted, proposed planning application / temporary events notice submitted by Argent / Savills to run a series of late Summer night Sports events in Cubitt Square / Stable Street this Summer.

Our son goes to bed at 7.30pm at night and these events, particularly the outdoor segment, will potentially be very disruptive to his evening / night time routine.

It is one thing doing the odd one off event during the day at weekends but I believe Argent's events team are on such a PR drive / Mission to promote the Kings Cross regeneration zone that they are not also taking into consideration how far into the scheme we now are.

Arthouse building on Handyside street opened and residents moved in over two years ago, Plimsoll opened and completed last Autumn and there are already many residents in this area, a few like ourselves with small babies and children, others are key workers and work night shifts. This will have a direct impact on them all.

I believe the planners are proposing quite regular sporting events over a two month period in the Summer which potentially means quite regular disruption to our right to peace and quiet in the evening and late at night.

With alcohol being imbibed and knowing full well how rowdy sports fans can become, this does present a concern for us and I believe a fair few others.
