					We object strongly to the very substantial loss of open garden space. It is one of the key elements of the significance of this group of buildings, within the context of the CA, that there is a substantial open green setting for the buildings – this is not only informed by the notions of the Picturesque, but also by the notion of Primrose Hill as a development which responded to concerns about public health and need for fresh air and open space for the urban population: the purpose of the founding of Primrose Hill itself as a public open space. The extent of loss here is seriously harmful to this significance, also to the setting of the Listed Building, and as a precedent which would open the way to serious cumulative harm to the character and appearance of the conservation area. We are also strongly opposed to the raising of the flank/boundary wall to 65. This would not only harm
					natural light in a corner which is already quite dark, but harm the sense of openness which is part of the larger concept of the area, as argued in our advice above.
