The Council has considered your application and decided to grant permission.

1 Reasons for granting permission.

The proposed samples correspond with the approved drawings and would be of high quality and incorporate materials which would preserve the character and appearance of the immediate area and the high status conservation area. It is



therefore recommended the details related to the windows (including jambs, head and cill), external doors associated with the replacement Kenwood Ladies' Pond Changing facility and all associated facing materials be discharged.

The full impact of the proposed development has already been assessed. The proposed details would not have a harmful impact on the appearance of the immediate area or on neighbouring amenity.

As such, the details are in general accordance with policy CS14 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Core Strategy, and policies DP24 and DP25 of the London Borough of Camden Local Development Framework Development Policies.

You are reminded that approval of details applications for the conditions 10 (sedum roofs), 11 (energy strategy), 15 (protected species license) are outstanding and require details to be submitted and approved.

In dealing with the application, the Council has sought to work with the applicant in a positive and proactive way in accordance with paragraphs 186 and 187 of the National Planning Policy Framework.
