

1. East Fence

1.10 @A3

- 1 Painted steel flats to match existing railings. Welded joints.
- 2 Circular rods to match existing in painted steel with welded joints.
- **3** Square support posts (replicating existing fence posts) in painted steel. Support posts resin anchored to concrete support wall see item 8.
- **4** Gate post set off wall to avoid the stone cill. Post to be fixed between mortar joints with resin anchor fixings. Countersunk heads, with slotted fixings to allow anchor bolt connections between mrotar joints.
- 5 Integrated lever handle / latch / lock

- **6** New concrete wall with new strip footing, full width.
- 7 New concrete step
- **8** Continuous plate to top of concrete wall to allow secure fixings for freestanding steel fence rail. Fencing not attached to existing railings.
- **9** Existing supports shown to rear indicatively. Supports will be retained and do not cross the line of the new fencing.
- 10 Existing fence and wall retained.
