The proposed design is inappropriate for a building of this size and scale within the conservation area. The design will look out of place in relation to the existing window openings in the facade of the building above. The application justifies the new shop front by referring to "the more modern style" of buildings to the southern side of Windmill Street. This building is of a completely different size and scale to that in which the application shopfront is situated, so the example used is irrelevant and misleading. The shop front of no 31 relates more obviously to that of the building immediately opposite and the proposed application shop front design would not be in keeping with this building either.
