**RE: 2016/1598/P – Goodge Street Underground Station, Tottenham Court Road, London, W1T 2HF
Installation of 3no. face mounted antennas painted to match the building fascia, the installation of 2no. CSC
cabinets and ancillary development thereto at roof level.**

Thank you for consulting Transport for London (TfL) Borough Planning on the above mentioned application. The building to which the installations are proposed is owned by London Underground however is not part of Goodge Street Underground Station, the entrance to the underground station is however adjacent to this building. The building is located on Tottenham Court Road which forms part of the Strategic Road Network (SRN) for which TfL controls the traffic signals but Camden Council is the highway authority.

TfL requests that the footway and carriageway on Tottenham Court Road is not blocked during the installations to the building. Temporary obstructions during the installations should be kept to a minimum and should not encroach on the clear space needed to provide safe passage for pedestrians or obstruct the flow of traffic on Tottenham Court Road.
